RULES.

Season 1948-49.

1.—This amalgamation of clubs shall be eal ed the Rusholme Amateur Football League and each Club must be a member of the Manchester County Football Association or kindred associations, and the league shall consist of not less than six properly constituted clubs. The clubs shall be Amateur organisations or such other clubs as are approved by the Management Committee, and their grounds or headquarters shall be situate within an eight mile radius of Rusholme Public Hall. All Clubs must be affiliated and no Club shall be allowed to play until their affiliation fee is paid.

2.—The Annual General Meeting shall be he'd in July each year. The object of the League shall be to create and maintain good sp. rtsmanship in Amateur Junior Football.

3.—The League shall be governed by a Committee to be called the Management Commuttee, which shall consist of a President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Vice-Presidents, S.x Independent Gentlemen, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer and a Divisional Club Representative, elected at the Annual General Meeting. The Representatives attending the He Annual General Meeting shall elect the Officers and, if in order, pass the balance

sheet, and discuss any other business of which due notice has been given. All elections to be by ballot, and in the event of the voting being equal the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote. All business transacted by the Management Committee shall be confirmed at the following monthly meeting.

4.—Each member of the Management Committee shall be entitled to attend all meetings and shall have one vote thereat. In the event of the voting being equal, the Chairman shall have, at such meeting, a second or costing vote. The Management Committee shall have power to deal with any offending Club or Clubs, Player or Players as they deem fit, and also to deal with any matter not provided for in these Rules. Five members of the Management Committee shall constitute a Quorum for the transaction of the business of the League.

5.—No Official or Player shall be allowed to plead ignorance of the Rules, and in order to avoid such, each team must purchase twelve Official League Handbooks, 9d. each.

6.—Each Club must send a representative to the League Monthly Meetings, such Representative to have power to vote. Failure to comply with this Rule shall entail a fine of the This Rule will be strictly enforced. 7.—The League's Monthly Meeting will be held on the last Thursday in the month at Heldquarters Openshaw Ragged School, George Street, Openshaw, commencing at 7-30 p.m. Each Club will be charged 4s, to cover the cost of all meetings. We hanged, Clubs will be notified.

8.—All matches played shall be pkiyed under the laws of the Football Association. Any Member of a Club shall be allowed to pkiy, provided he has not been previously registered with the League for another Club. A player signing for more than one Club shall be dea't with by the Management Committee, who shall also decide upon his registration. Each player must sign his own registration form in handwriting, and countersigned by the Club Secretary. (Block Letters will not be accepted). Registration forms must be in the hands of the League Secretary three clear days before any League Match.

9.—Any Club desiring the transfer of a registered player must first obtain the permission of the Club with which he is registered before approaching him, or will be liable to be dealt with by the Management Committee. When a Club refuses the transfer desired by a player or Club, the said player or Club may lay the case before the League Secretary, who will call a meeting of the

Management Committee, which, having been satisfied that the player in question has a bona-fide reason for desiring to transfer (the onus of proving a satisfactory reason rests with the player), shall have full power tedeal with the matter as they think fit. Any Cub in ringing this rule and playing ineligible men, shall have Two Points deducted from its score for each offence, and a fine not exceeding 10s., and the match may be replayed. In the case of a replay, the defaulting Club will have to pay all expenses.

10.—Application for Transfer Form, 1s. each, must be made to the League Secretary. The Transfer Form must be signed by the Secretary of each Club and the player concerned the League Secretary shall acknowledge such oransfer before the player becomes eligible to play for his new Club.

11.—The Trustees of the League shall be the Chairman, Secretary, and Hon. Treasurer for the time being, and they shall be for all intents and purposes the Legal Holders in Trust for the League.

Any Cauh delaying the start beyond the time fixed shall be fined a minimum of 1s. The Referee must fill in the correct time of kick-off on the card supplied for that purpess, and must also report any Club for late kick-off. Clubs must likewise report late artival of the referee. In case a referee fails to jut in an appearance 15 minutes after the time of kick-off, the Clubs toss for choice unless a registered referee is available; the saming to be puid as an official referee, the home Club Sceretary to forward the result sheet to the League Secretary.

19.—A Professional, playing under permit, that not be elegible to play in the League

competitions.

Any team commencing a game with a current with a game with a low any player who turns up late on the field without first reporting to the referee and signing the card. It is imperative that all players must each sign the referee's card in their own handwriting. Action will be taken by the Management Committee against players or Clubs violating this Rule. Should any team play short, a fine of 1s, per player will be imposed.

20.—Al! protests must be lodged with the Longue Secretary in duplicate within seven they so of the date of the match to which they refer and must be accompanied by a fee of

20s., which fee may be forfeited if in the cpinion of th Management, the protest be deemed frivolous. Any Club not satisfied with the decision of the League shall have power to submit its case to the Board of Appeal. Notice of appeal must be in writing and sent in triplicate to the League Secretary within three days accompanied by a deposit of 20s., which shall be forfeited to the funds of the League in the event of the appeal being dismissed (but not otherwise). The decisions of the Board of Appeal shall be final.

21.—Clubs shall be called upon to see that their ground is properly marked out. Corner flags erected for all games and goal posts to be fenced where nets are not used. No Club shall be allowed to enter the League unless they have suitable dressing accommodation. Clubs are urged to provide separate dressing accommodation for the referee where possible. In the Open-Age Divisions, Clubs are urged to provide Goal Nets.

22.—No alterations or additions to be made to these Ru'es, except at the Annual General Meeting, and 28 days' notice must be given to the Hon. Secretary of any proposed alterations or additions, and such alterations or additions shal not be deemed carried unless supported by at least two-thirds of the members present. Any Club deemed guilty of conduct unworthy of Amateur Football, will be

expelled from the League at a General Meeting and its record expunged. An Extra-ordinary General Meeting may be called on a requisition signed by at least 12 Clubs.

23.—Home Clubs must advise visiting Clubs of the direction to Dressing Room and all either particulars three days before date of match. Failing to do so, offenders will be fined 1s. Any complaints in connection with the League, i.e., Clubs, Referee, Ground, Dressing Room, Spectators, etc., must be in writing to the League Secretary within seven days of the match.

21.—No Clubs shall visit the ground of its cponcent twice without the consent of the League Management. In the event of a Club failing to keep an engagement, the defaulting Club will be held responsible for helf referee fee and reasonable expenses incurred. All fines must be paid within 28 days from the date on which they are imposed. (This Rule will be strictly enforced).

SPECIAL RULES.

The attention of the Clubs is specially directed to the following Rules adopted by the League.

1.-In order that the League Competition

may be carried out in a fair sportsmanlike manner, the Management have empowered Referees in all League Matches and Cup Ties to put down the slightest attempt at rough play and intimidation. They have also power to close the game at any time for the same cause or where interference comes from the spectators. The home team shall be held responsible for the personal safety of the Referee. Speciators of any match stopped by the Referee on this account will not obtain the return of money paid for admission. The Referee has power to order any player off the field for foul language or rough play. If a Referee orders a player off the field for misconduct or any other offence, he must report such action to the Local County Association within three days of the occurrence. No match will be allowed to be played for four points.

2.—All correspondence to the League Secretary requiring an answer must have a stamped addressed envelope, otherwise the expenses incurred will be charged to the Club's account. The League to have prior claim on any ground or players for special matches inter-league, trial or charity matches free of

charge.

3.—No Club is allowed to transfer or register a player after March 21st in, any year. There shall be no limit to the number of players registered. Registration Forms, 34. each,

shit, be confirmed at the following Monthly Locgue Meetings of the Clubs.

CUP RULES.

All Cups are the property of the League and cannot be won outright or become the bermanent property of any Club, and shall be returned to the League Secretary not later than March 1st of any year. The Winners and Runners-up will receive a set of medals or suitable trophies, 11 in each set.

Clubs winning Cups will be required to insure same with some reliable Insurance Company, and deposit the policy with the Leagus Scietary. The Cups shall be handed over to the representatives of such Clubs on receiving a document to the following effect, and signed by persons whose names shall have previously been submitted to and approved by the Management Committee. (See Rule 20. M.C.F.A. Cup Rule).

All registered players must have played in at least four league matches before the first and subsequent rounds. No players to player for two teams in the Cup Competition the same season.

The League to take the whole of the proceeds of the Cup Semi-Finals and Finals. The

trustees of the Cup shall be the League Trustees.

Protests in Cup Ties. (See Rule 20).

All Clubs must enter for their Divisional Challenge Cup Competition.

Open Age Divisions, Entrance Fee 7s. 6d.

All League Fees must be paid by September 1st, or drastic action will be taken by the f.eague Management.

INSTRUCTIONS TO REFEREES.

Referees must confirm their appointments, giving all details of matches accepted, within three days of receipt of same.

Referees are requested to send a brief report of their matches by first post Monday to the Loague Secretary.

Referees must apply for re-registration to the League Secretary enclosing a stamped eddressed envelope for reply before July 1st each season.

If at all practicable, Referees must allow games to be completed. Where the match

starts to time, or light permits, the game must be of 90 minutes duration where possible.

Referees should not necessarily delay the kick-off when teams have not their full compenent of players.

All Cup games to be of 90 minutes duration where possible. In case of drawn games, eaten time must be played in all rounds up to the Semi-Finals.

Referees should report all cases where teams commence a game late or short-handed, where the ground is declared unfit, or where the game is abandoned, also their own late arrival. Offending Clubs to be notified at the commencement of the match that he is reporting them.

A'll reports to be in the hands of the League Secretary within three days. Any Referce with an open date would do well to advise the League Secretary early in the week or 'Phone RUSholme 1009.

Referees must report injury to players immed ately after the match.

BENEVOLENT FUND. RULES.

1.—That the Clubs pay a levy of 1s. per weatch, date to be stated, same to be paid on or before, each Monthly Meeting, or when any

p'ay takes place 1s. is due. Entrance fee 4s. for each new Club, payable in advance.

2.—That the Funds be distributed by a Sub-Committee of Clubs and League Management Committee.

3.—That if necessary the League shall grant a benefit match each year, and any Club shall lean their ground free of charge, and shall release all players required to play in each such match.

4.—That in case a player is injured, and unabe to follow his employment through an accident caused whist playing football in any Rusholme and District League match or Rusholme and District League Cup Ties, his Club may appeal for benefit. Any other matches sunctioned by League Management must be sent to the Benevolent Fund Sccretary three days prior to the match.

 Notification of accident must be sent to Benevolent Fund Secretary by Tuesday night accompanied by doctor's certificate and vecified by referee.

6.—That the Funds be lodged with the Trustees of the League under a separate heading, and should any funds remain in band at the end of the senson, they shall be carried forward to the following season.

7.—That ener Club be in arrears, their playare shall be excluded from benefits. 8.—On receiving a claim, the Secretary shall call the Committee together and, on being satisfied with the bona-fides of the claim, shall grant the injured player 10s. a week for a period of 6 weeks, when, if necessary, a grant may be extended to 12 weeks providing funds available. Receipt for payment must be sent immediately.

9.—A player shall not be entitled to benefits who has misconducted himself so as to retard recovery.

10.—A convalescent player desirous of resuning his employment, shall, after obtaining the doctor's consent, send a signing off note to the Secretary within 24 hours of resuming his employment, but should a player after wards find that he is unable to continue his emovement, he must notify the Secretary within three days of declaring off date, and make territer application for benefit.

11.—Anything not provided for in these Ru'es shall be dealt with as the Committee deem advisable.

12.—These Rules to be revised at the end of each season.

13.—In the event of the Fund being wound up the Management Committee shall distribute some to charities approved by the Manchester C.F.A.

14.—A'l Clubs must join the Benevolent Fund.


